PAUW FOUNDATION MAKES HISTORICAL \$350,000 DONATION TO LOCAL SCHOOL DIVISION

June 20, 2019 - Banff, Alberta, Canada

The Wim & Nancy Pauw Foundation announces a significant \$350,000 donation to Canadian Rockies Public Schools. The largest historical donation to schools in the Bow Valley, the Wim & Nancy Pauw Foundation commits to a partnership that supports enhanced programming for CRPS students, with a shared goal of creating a 'best-ever' school experience. The goal is to endorse unique, made-in-the-mountains programs that enhance traditional learning, and to ensure affordability for programs such as athletics, that have high costs of participation.

DETAILS

- A total \$350,000 donation to CRPS for the 2019-2020 school year
 - \$113,000 allocated to EXTRACURRICULAR AND ATHLETICS including fee supplementation for extracurricular sports at the Banff and Canmore high schools and Banff Elementary School and full funding for Outdoor Pursuits programs at Banff Elementary and Elizabeth Rummel School
 - \$135,000 allocated to OUTDOOR EDUCATION supporting nature based learning programs at Banff Elementary School and the Canmore elementary schools, fee supplementation for high school students taking outdoor courses as options, and capacity building for the Canadian Rockies Outdoor Learning Centre
 - \$107,000 allocated to ACADEMICS & WELLNESS including support for Dual Credit opportunities, Creative Learning, Mental Health & Wellness, and graduate scholarships

HIGHLIGHTS

- Included in the above, \$75,000 is NEW funding towards Mental Health & Wellness initiatives, responding to an increasing need for psychological resources and seamless, normalized processes for students and their families seeking emotional support.
- Included in the above, and NEW this year, valued at \$75,000, is an extension of Wim & Nancy
 Pauw Foundation funding into the Canmore school communities with athletic fee funding,
 nature based learning, and Outdoor Pursuits for Canmore students
