1. offer sport, activity, and recreational amateur programs for youth 17 and younger
2. operate as a not-for-profit organization
3. be based in the Bow Valley with the majority of programming targeted towards Bow Valley youth residents
4. be a member of True Sport and demonstrate a commitment to the **True Sport Principles**
5. have stable financial practices
6. commit to providing one digital True Sport story during the season; to be collated with the help of Pauw Foundation if required; that demonstrates the importance of one True Sport principle or highlights the value of including all 7 True Sport Principles within your programming

Applications must include:

- Complete applications following the format of the questions provided
- Most current approved, year-ending financial statement
- Responses to the questions provided
